- ODU's Writing Sample Placement test must be taken BEFORE the completion of your first semester. You can arrange for this by calling the Testing Center (683-3697). FAILURE TO DO THIS WILL RESULT IN A HOLD!**
- If you do not have credit for College Algebra you must take the COMPASS Math Diagnostic Test. This must be done at least 4 weeks prior to registering for any math course. You can arrange for this by calling the Testing Center (683-3697).**
