

Zoological Parks Management Core Requirements:

In addition to the Zoological Parks Management Concentration Requirements described below, all Students must meet the University General Education Upper and Lower division requirements. (See Appropriate Catalog). A minimum of 120 credits hours are required for the B.S. degree. Students must also complete the Exit Examination of Writing Proficiency and the Senior Assessment survey prior to graduation.
