Condensed admission and continuance information:

Admission

Students seeking regular admission into the licensure only program must:

1. apply for admission to Old Dominion University as a non-degree seeking graduate student;
2. hold at least a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution;
3. have achieved a cumulative GPA of 2.75 for all college credit courses taken in the baccalaureate degree program;
4. achieve passing Praxis I or Virginia Board of Education-approved SAT or ACT score requirements as outlined by the Commonwealth of Virginia;
5. interview and receive recommendation for admittance from a department representative, Teacher Education Services advisor, or site director; and,
6. submit an application for admittance into the Darden College of Education Teacher “Licensure Only” Program. Only 12 hours of professional education courses from another institution may transfer into a licensure only program.

Continuance

1. Complete all content area courses and requirements for licensure in subject area.
2. Maintain a GPA of 2.75
3. Attain passing scores on the Praxis II examination and the Virginia Communication and Literacy Assessment (VCLA) examination.
